Requirements for execution of submitted materials:

- We ask you to send the articles in MS Word on the disc, font – Times New Roman, with 14 point size, line-to-line spacing – 1,5; The volume of the article – 8-12 pages in A4 format (along with the bibliography); the text should not contain manual hyphenation;
- The article should be presented in the following sequence: in the upper right corner – the author's name and surname in Ukrainian and English, academic degree, position, full name of the educational (scientific) institution; below in the center – the title, abstract of the article and keywords in Ukrainian and English.
- The reference in the text to the source should be accompanied by footnotes, which are given as follows: at the end of the sentence, which uses the quote, facts, dates, etc., at the top the reference number is indicated by the corresponding digits, and at the bottom of the page under the same line number is given the reference. At the end of the article there should be a list of references and literature;
- The text should be edited and verified; surnames and other proper names, as well as the terms should be verified and unified. It is advisable to avoid abbreviations, and if necessary, you should decode them.
